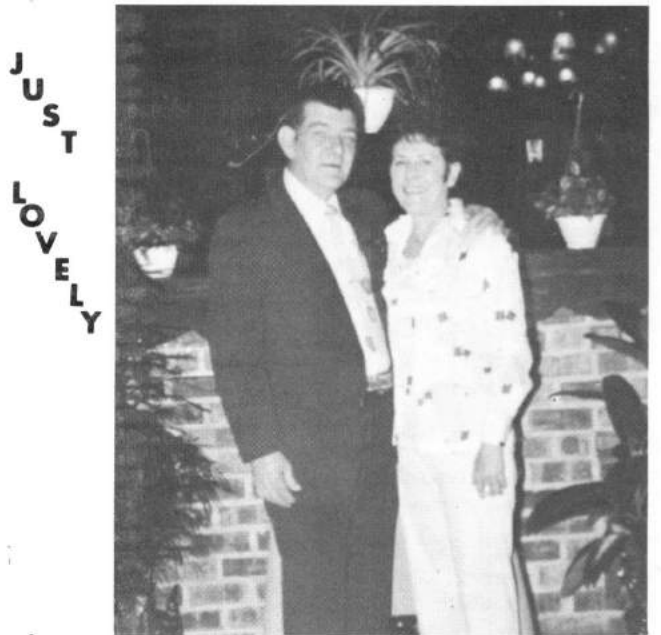

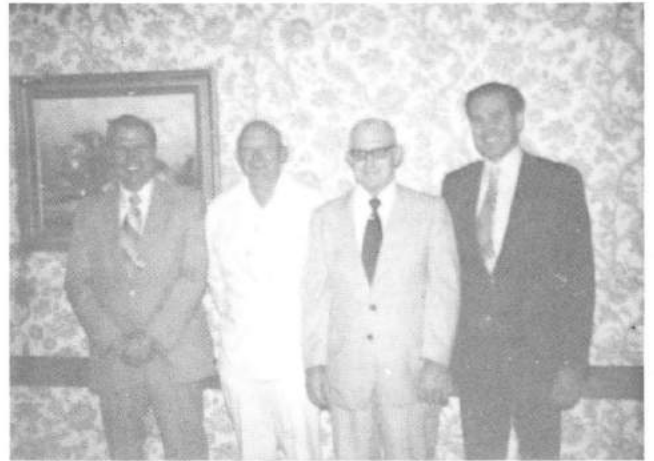

Just a line to let you know that my husband
Daniel Hagman passed away July 20, 1976 of Cancer.
Please don't send the Thunderbolt anymore.

The following was taken from the Veterans
Hospital News where he spent two years:

He lived with his wife Lois in Oceanside CA.
Before entering the service, he handled Travel
Service in New York City. In 1942 he enlisted in the
Army at Washington, D.C. He became an Infantry Tech
Sergeant and served under Generals Patton and Hodges
in England, France Holland, Belgium, Luxembourg and
Germany. He earned the Purple Heart and two Bronze
Star Medals. After his discharge, he was a Traffic
Manager with the U.S. Government in the Washington
D.C. area. His way of looking at each day is: 'Keep
your chin up....you could be a lot worse off than you
are.'

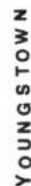
