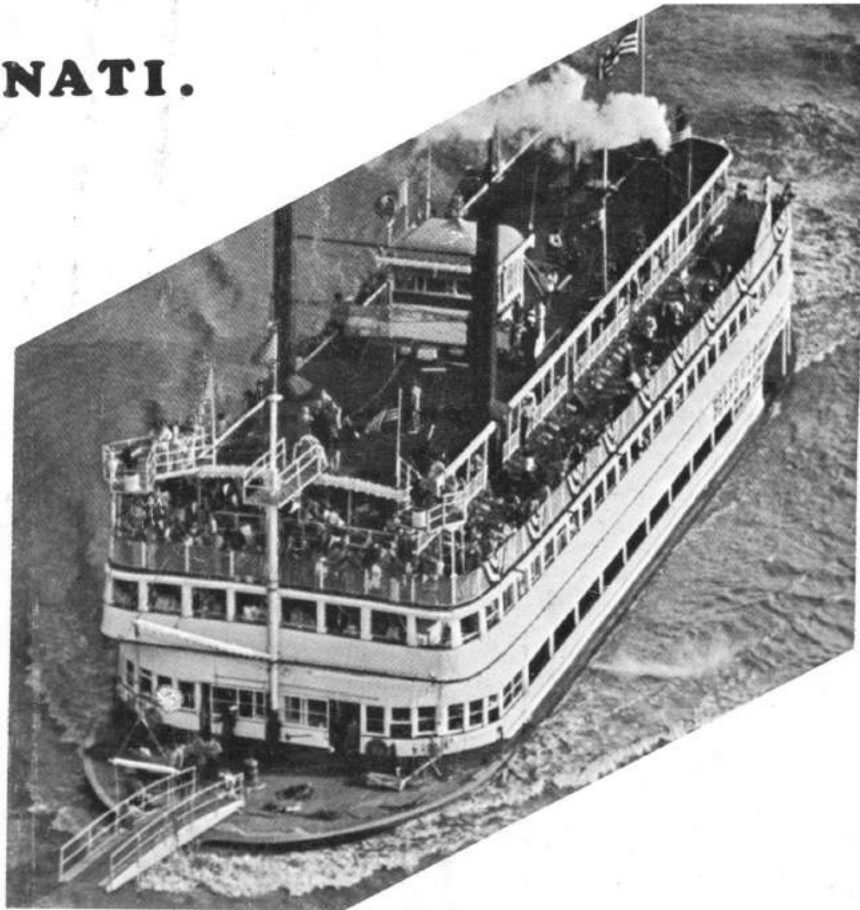

## SECRETARY-TREASURER REPORT

This being the last report for this year, I'll try to cover all the necessary matters of interest to all of you.

First things first. Another great and record breaking year for our Association. We moved over the 1200 mark in paid-up members for the first time in our History and "Thank You's" are in order for all of you that have been writing to your Buddies. Like I always said before; "the personal letter is the best advertising we can get. CONGRADULATIONS!!!

Financially, we are still stable but I don't know what the future has in store for us. Postage rates have been on the rise for several years now and this latest raise is going to play havoc with us. Our Third Class cost on mailing the single, two or three THUNDERBOLTS has gone up exactly 50% and I was told this is not the end of it. We'll just have to wait and see what the outcome will be.

Thus far, we have given Charters to New England, Florida and Kentucky and this is a good sign which will surely create more interest in those areas. I am still waiting for West Virginia to get their group together soon, to qualify for the Charter they are seeking. Out west, in California, Buzz Bizzini is working hard to get a California Chapter started and it looks as though they may qualify very soon. There has been nothing new arise in the Indianapolis Chapter renewal but I am still hoping. There have been no reports from the Baltimore - Washington, D.C. area.

At our Board Meeting in Cincinnati, Ohio, we learned from Dick Riddle that the Dixie Chapter wants to get a new Charter. This would require doing away with the old Charter before issuing the new one. A change in the name of the new one would be necessary. We are in the process of going into this changeover now and will know more by Reunion time.

The Florida Chapter was presented with a Charter at a Meeting held at the Rodeway Inn (next to the Sheraton Towers where we had our Orlando Reunion) in Orlando and yours truly had the great honor of presenting the Charter to President Sullivan. I really enjoyed being there for the presentation with such a fine group of people in attendance. On behalf of the entire 83rd Infantry Division Association Inc., CONGRADULATIONS!! We wish you every success.

We already have several hundred paid-up members for the year 1978-'79 and those of you that are not planning to be at the Cincinnati Reunion, should send your Dues in now so you will not miss out on future THUNDERBOLTS and other news throughout the coming year. Those of you that were paid for 1977-'78 will get the THUNDERBOLT following the next Reunion and then be removed from the roster. Last year, three notices were sent out, but because of the increased cost of mailing now, this may be reduced to one or two. Be prompt, do your share to help keep our expenses down. PAY YOUR DUES NOW while the thought is fresh in your mind.

Being that this THUNDERBOLT contains all the names and addresses of our paid-up members, I cut down on the size of type and spacing in order that we can stay with the 28 page book. All articles are being cut the same and I hope you don't mind the change. A 40 page book almost doubles the cost to the Association.

The next deadline for the THUNDERBOLT is September 10, 1978 and all news should be in this office by the 8th. Please help me to stay with the deadlines.

NOW is the time to pay your Dues for 1978-'79. Save yourself the trouble of losing out on the THUNDERBOLTS and all other news throughout the year. Soon you'll be reading about the plans for the New Orleans Reunion in 1979.

ADDRESS CHANGES ---- I can't stress this point to you enough. This past year, I have had to get rid of hundreds of cards and stencils because of wrong addresses, our people move and leave no forwarding address. Much of the problem is the fault of the Post Office. No matter whose fault it is, I

have to pay \$.25 for each letter returned to me. The Post Office supplies you with Change-of-address cards and if you don't put a \$.09 stamp on it, that cost us \$.25 too. This past year alone, we paid out hundreds of Quarters.

Cincinnati is shaping up as one of our very best Reunions and I'm sure none of you will want to miss it. Hope you sent in your Reservation Cards and all plans are complete to attend this great affair.

Many, many Thanks to our THUNDERBOLT writers of the past year. Thanks also to all those that wrote letters to their Buddies and encouraged them to join us and come to the Reunions. This is the sort of help that keeps our 83rd right at the top in standings with other Associations.

Before I forget, I went to Ft. Benning for the fourth time and am finally satisfied that we are going to get the display that we bargained for. Mr. Grube, the Curator of the Infantry Museum convinced me that he would see to it personally. He accepted all our History Collection and should have it put on display shortly. If any of you stop there after a few months, drop me a line as to your thoughts on our display so we can tell others about it.

Before closing, I thought I had better remind all of you of the change in the Reunion Program. THE MEMORIAL SERVICE WILL BE ON THURSDAY THIS YEAR. The change was very necessary to fit in with the planning.

Saturday will be open for the ladies to do as they please.

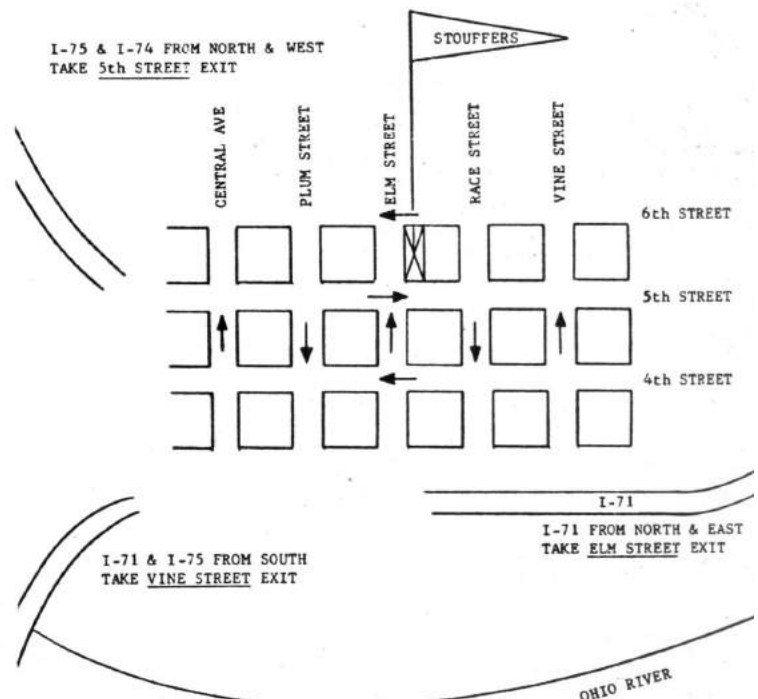
For Unit Luncheons contact one of the Host Chapter who will in turn put you in touch with the appropriate Hotel personnel.

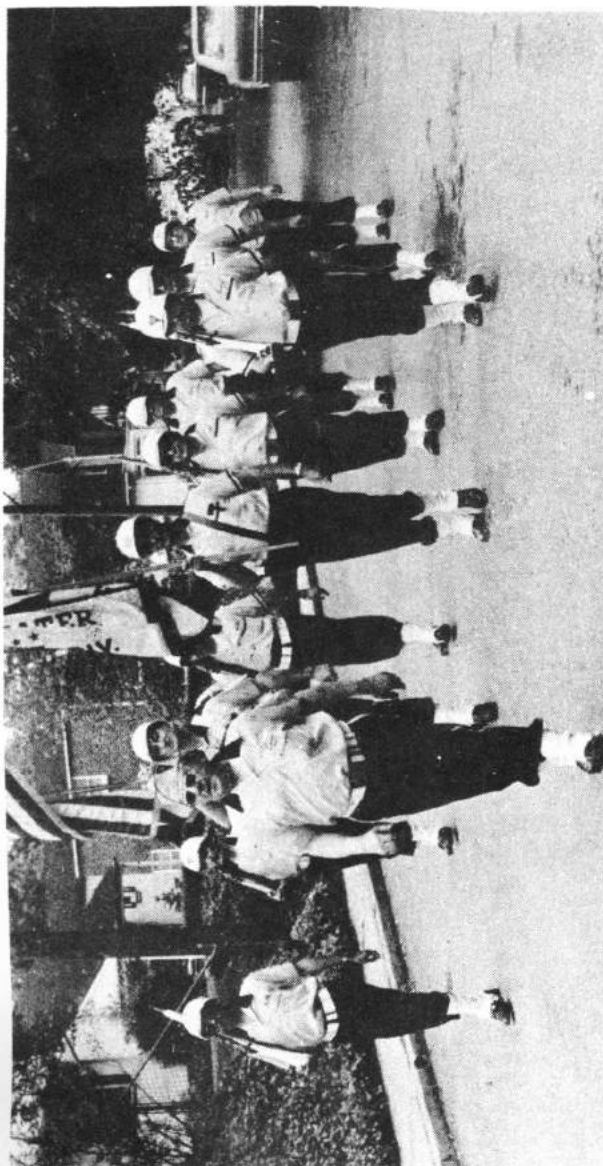
