Many in our group got ill from the weather and some from the food and water. Bernie Epstein of the 308th Medics was along on the tour and turned out to be our "Doc" while his wife did the nursing chores. We are thankful to both.

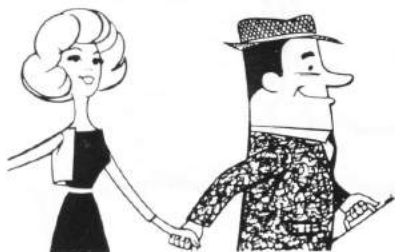
In general, we had a lot of fun, spread the name of the 83rd all over the place and I'm sure everyone was quite happy.

## A LOVE AFFAIR

My brother Bill in World War II, was a Staff Sergeant in "H" 330, 83rd Infantry Division, U.S. Army. With him, I travelled as Chaplain of the 83rd Infantry Division Association on two ETO tours, one in 1973 and the other in 1976. Now that I knew my way, I wanted in 1978 to go it alone and slowly. Some might call this an odyssey, some a pilgrimage. I call it a LOVE AFFAIR. I love my country and especially those who died for it, heroes or not. I've roamed the battlefields of the Revolutionary and Civil Wars and now those of both World Wars. My Superiors had told me on my 40th Anniversary as a priest, to go to Rome. An old saying used to be, "All Roads Lead To Rome." As they say in navigation, I took the great circle route - Brussels, Luxembourg, Paris, Normandy, Zurich, Milan, Venice, Florence and Rome. (I visited the cemetery at Anzio Nettuno, also.)

I visited battlefields and cemeteries other than those I'd seen before, such as St. James in Brittany, Omaha Beach and Hamm in Luxembourg (tho I visited the latter two again.) At Hamm on Memorial Day, General George S. Patton II gave the inspiring talk. He has a much better speaking voice than his father. After the talk, there was a flyover by four jets from the U.S. Air Base at Bitburg, Germany - three minutes away. (Did you know it took a special Act of Congress to change the body of General George S. Patton, Jr. to the front of the Hamm Cemetery so that he now faces his troops? It's the only case in any of our cemeteries.) A few days later, on June 5, I was asked by the 101st Airborne Association in Carentan, to lay the Memorial Wreath at the base of their Monument in front of the City Hall; Lt. Col. John H. Lyons U.S.A. (Ret.) is President. He married a Carentan girl in 1946 and now lives there after a full career in the Service.

June 6, I went to Omaha Cemetery. It was sad to see only about 12 cars there on D Day Anniversary. Omaha is not memorialized as is Utah Beach, where seven countries were celebrating D Day that June 6, 1978. I heard that only at Arromanches and Utah is any celebrating done on June 6 every year in rotation. The British care for the Big Museum at Arromanches while the townspeople of St. Marie du Mont care for Utah. The town Mayor was a youth on June 6, 1944, and while telling the G.I.'s not to machine gun the cellars where the civilians were hiding, was himself shot down by one G.I. - nine bullets hitting him. He was taken to England and never forgot the care and solicitude of the Americans in helping his recovery. Omaha is thus the forgotten stepchild. Even the wife of Lt. Col. Lyons (a native of Carentan) is incensed that her people have forgotten the Americans. They have adopted a city in Germany and invite them to give annual concerts and even play soccer. Charity, she says, is fine, but let's not forget the Americans.

I spent a full week touring the entire stretch of 50 miles - the five beaches - starting with Ouistreham on the Orne River, northeast of Caen. With tour-guide book in hand, I probed all the beaches and even the back stretches of the land over which the soldiers had to fight. In Normandy there are 18 British and Canadian Cemeteries. Within a 10 mile radius of Caen are buried thousands and thousands of young men from both sides. What a waste! No wonder Gen. de Gaulle and President Konrad Adenauer got together at the Reims Cathedral and pledged no more war. I also visited three German Cemeteries. It must also grieve those many German relatives to see these. If you go to Hamm Cemetery to see General Patton, just walk another hundred yards to the left of the gate. There you will see a big German Cemetery with 11,000 buried in it - 5,000 of them in one mass grave. Another one is at LaCambe close by Omaha. It is on Route 13 about 8 miles east of Isigny. La Cambe originally was an American Cemetery until 1947 when 5,000 bodies were sent home or to Omaha. In 1948 the German government then obtained permission to use it and now has 10,000 bodies there.

At Omaha Beach I went right down to the water and actually drove on and along the beach from St. Honorine exit to the Coleville exit. Then, I walked to the Vierville exit. It's frightening to look up at those 200 foot high cliffs scaled by the 1st and 29th Divisions. The other four beaches were flat and thus had less casualties. Did you know that General Omar Bradley thought about calling Omaha off that June 6? After 1:00 P.M., our fortunes changed, but not for the 3,000 casualties. Sword, Juno and Gold beaches, going west, have many more mementos than Utah or Omaha. At the town of Graye in the Juno sector, there is a DD Tank on a cement base put there after having spent 27 years in the sea. It had sunk when its collapsible canvas wings had been riddled with bullets. An odd memento also at Graye, is an immense crucifix commemorating Gen. de Gaulle's arrival on Norman soil, June

14. Nothing is said about Churchill arriving there from the sea two days earlier or George VI (the King) two days later. Any number of German block houses can be seen from Merville on the Orne west to Arromanches, maybe a couple of dozen - practically none where we landed - Utah and Omaha.

I found a similar trait amongst British, French and German and that is that no one advertises his mistakes. On the ETO Tour in 1973 we could not find the approaches to the ruins of the Remagen Bridge in Germany. The bridge is gone, but the casements (towers) on either side of the Rhine, still remain. No signs! Even the entrance is blocked by huge piles of dirt in back of a factory. Yet this was the first crossing of the Rhine. The British have markers for some battles - BUT! On Route D-8, six miles southwest of Caen is Hill 112 west of Maltot; the 43rd British Wessex Division has a Plaque on a Monument saying it took this hill; but you'll find nothing about their going no further for about five more weeks. The right book of Monty called "Operation Epsom" was stopped cold right there, June 30. Prior to this there was a wider right book by Monty around Caen by the famous Desert Rats of Africa - the British 7th Armored Division. They were stopped cold at Hill 213 outside of Villers Bocage, a town 25 miles southwest of Caen on Route N-175. One tank of the Panzer Lehr knocked out 25 Armored vehicles before the rest came up and beat the Desert Rats. 'Twas a blot on their history - but no marker there today. On Omaha and other beaches you see German mistakes. Those block houses standing today are still trained to the east for most part as then; they expected us to come in at high tide and without tanks. We did the opposite.

At Carentan, I heard some French say they were 19 or 20 at the time in 1944. After the city had been secured by the 101st Airborne, the Mayor told them to clean up the bodies in the fields, as some of them had been rotting since D-Day. In one particular field they picked up 98 German bodies and 65 American Paratroopers - one German standing upright impaled to a tree by a bayonet! 'Tis said this was the only real bayonet battle in the war. A woman told us she corresponds with a 101st man and when he returned to see the field where he had landed, he was driven off by a couple holding a rifle on him. They now own the land and tho' he'd told them (thru her) they still wanted no one there. Carentan is really forgetting, or not caring.

Ever hear of C.E.B.A.? It means Circle of Studies for the Battle of the Ardennes. It is run by Luxembourgers. So I went to see the Kimmes family and the Schoetterts and the Kolns - all of whom run this organization. I was again reminded of that country via Kent O'Connell's column the history of the 83rd in the THUNDERBOLT, he has been telling of different battalions in Reserve training for the Siegfried Wall by using the Maginot Line at Hettange Grande. I was in the Maginot Line at Fort Hackenberg. A Catholic Priest friend of Johnny "Reb" Folsom (A 330) in Burmeange took me to this fort. The French don't advertise their mistakes. So there is no publicity about this fort or another near St. Avold. It is halfway between Helling and Veckring on Route D-60, about 15 kilometers east of Thionville, which in turn is just north of Metz. You must go to the Mayors Office in one of these two towns, wait for a group to form either in the English, French or German guide language. Go in any language. I went in the German. Luckily this Luxembourg priest knew German. To think that 1200 French soldiers lived in its underground miles and that a small gauge railroad runs for miles on which you can still ride in open cars! You see the living quarters, the alcoves for the ammo, the big generators still working and also the raising and lowering of one big 155 still in working order. Topside you can see the view they had and the formidable tank traps. The 80th Division shot up the outskirts in 1944.

Before leaving, the Luxembourgers: - when building their homes even today, they build strong cellars in case of future invasions and shellings. They trust nothing. Occasionally you hear three different types of sirens, in preparation for invasions. One type means General Alarm, another Planes Coming and another Bombs Dropping. In Helsenborn east of Wiltz, the Pastor showed me a Crucifix he had made out of five (5) five-inch pieces of shrapnel. He had been the Pastor of Winseler, east of Wiltz (which is about ten miles southeast of Bastogne) while the 26th Division drove up through it during the Bulge. In this town of Winseler lived a youngster of eleven in 1944 who is now the Adjutant of the State Police Superintendent of Luxembourg City. (To enter the Police you must first serve three years in the Army!) His name is Joseph Schoettert and he is a founder and contributor to C.E.B.A., of which we wrote earlier. During the Invasion he and 12 others were forced by the SS to live in a cellar of his home in about twenty by twenty feet of space. A Pig Sty was in one corner and they crowded in there for two weeks during all the shelling with six bells bouncing off the roof. One night he used a Candle and burned a Cross in the ceiling of the cellar. At night he'd Pray to the Cross for protection.

I saw the Cross which is still there. He had done this while lying on his back on the top bunk.

Next, we go to the cemetery at St. Avoird, 28 miles east of Metz. It's the largest in Europe, with over 10,000 dead. Some from the 83rd; but most are from the 80th Division. Lorraine in which this cemetery is situated, is as beautiful as any state in the U.S.

To the southwest of Metz is the town of Thiaucourt. Here are buried the dead of St. Mihiel, 4,100 of them, and the third largest in Europe of all the cemeteries. It should interest us deeply, because in 1918 it was at St. Mihiel that the Americans were first allowed to function as a unit under General Pershing. With 9 Divisions in battle and 5 in reserve, he took what the Germans had fortified for four years in the space of 3½ days at a cost of 10,000 casualties. At Montsec, 12 miles southwest, and a part of the battle, is a big Memorial. It scans and commands heights for a radius of 20 miles to the Moselle. I think that it was here General George S. Patton, Jr. first got bit.

Verdun was next. A ten month battle between French and German troops in 1916. There's a Memorial there under which 300,000 bodies are buried - all of whose names are on the inside walls. Another big cemetery still is on the outside. What a waste! Over one million casualties on both sides.

Next the Meuse Argonne, about 35 miles west of Verdun on Route D-998 or ten miles north of Montfaucon. In the middle of the area is Romagne in which is the cemetery containing 14,000 of the Argonne dead. I didn't like so many trees being planted amongst the 8 plots for they obscure the panorama. To take down a tree demands Congressional approval - believe it or not! At Varennes, the jumpoff point, you see an immense Memorial put there by the 28th Pennsylvania Division.

At Belleau (Aisne-Marne) where next I went, the 26th Infantry Division used the town Church as a Memorial. Working with the French Government, they rebuilt the Church destroyed by gunfire. 'Tis opposite the cemetery. Outside the Church is a Memorial to them while inside is a bas relief of General Edwards, the sacked General of the 26th. On the inside walls are the names of all 26th men killed in that Theater. The actual cemetery contains 2300 bodies. It's only 8 miles northwest of Chateau Thierry and near the actual Belleau Woods in which the battle was fought in 1918. The Keeper (a South Side Chicago man with a British accent) told me they now lock the Chapel on the grounds. Prior to that, some night campers went in, started a fire with the wooden kneelers, had stayed overnight and even stole a three foot high wooden Statue of Virgin Mary. Gangs are now organized which case a place and come back to steal something you may want tho' you don't know where it came from - like cars or parts over here in the U.S.A. It's too bad the 83rd does not have Memorials or Plaques in Europe. A suggestion would be to have C.E.B.A. do it for you. They have done it for the 26th and they protect them from vandalism by replacing them - real watch dogs.

One thing you don't have to worry about is noise in the World War I cemeteries. Few ever visit them. Eventually this is going to happen to Omaha Beach, etc., of World War II. Cemeteries of WW I are built inland, away from the noise. The forests are so quiet that you can hear your own breath. One time only were my silent reveries broken. At Argonne, I sat munching on bread and cheese and drinking mineral water when two French jets suddenly came over at tree level wagging their wings. A nice gesture! Honoring the dead no doubt.

There is no Memorial or Plaque that I could find of our Medal of Honor winner from Tennessee, Sgt. Alvin York of the 82nd Division. I went to Hill 223 where he won it in 1918. It is situated between Cornay and Chatel Chebery, 15 miles southwest of Remagne Cemetery on Route D-4. About 5 miles south of this is Binarville. Take R-63 north a mile and then right on D-442. A mile or two you'll see a sign: "Lost Battalion" by the road, above a lake. It took some years for the names on the marker to be allowed - 307 and 308 Regiments, plus 306 M.G. Regiment of the 77th Division. The Company Commander later killed himself after the war, still blaming himself. There are arguments that Argonne was not necessary, the same as Huertgen - that they could have been skirted. We'll never know, will we?

Next to Oise-Aisne Cemetery on Route N-367 about 25 miles north of Chateau Thierry. Here is buried Joyce Kilmer, the Poet and author of "Trees." It really is two miles east of Fere. The British (!!) caretaker told me it galls him to hear the BBC in England say that Kilmer is buried in a cemetery near Paris instead of naming it Fere. Kilmer's Cross is deliberately fakened in the print so that it is easy to photograph and not lose the wording. The same on General Patton's Cross at Hamm.

So much for all the cemeteries. If you're interested, remember there is one just 5 miles west of Paris - another 7½ miles south of

Florence - even one 28 miles west of London. All can be reached by public conveyance easily.

A few final thoughts: Montgomery had six Operations in six weeks before he took the city of Caen in Normandy, tho' he'd planned to occupy it in four days originally. When you stand south of the city or east of it you can see why the Germans needed to contain the British. It is perfectly flat, wide open and no hedge rows. Yet superb hills helped them stop the British. There were two right hooks and two left hooks and atleast one frontal attack on Caen. I stood where all of them were stopped. The most fascinating is east of Caen right on Route 5 at Cagny (no "e" in it like Jimmy Cagney's name.) This is where 76 of the infamous 88's stood and raked 700 British tanks to pieces as they tried to push through a width of only one mile south to Bourquebus Ridge.

Two of the founders of C.E.B.A. showed me interesting things. This C.E.B.A. means "Circle of Studies of the Battle of the Ardennes." Luxembourgers in their teens at the time of 1944 but now intensely interested in collating all the material they can derive from survivors of the Bulge even to renting and staffing a Museum at Clerveaux. Camille Koln told me that in the past year a wallet was found in a barn at Cansdorf. In it was the name of a G.I. from Detroit, with his actual Social Security card and some Invasion Money. Another man named Joseph Schoettert took me to a battle site near his 1944 home in Winseler. It intrigued me as well as him. In John Toland's book, "The Battle of the Bulge" he speaks of near panic of green troops of Company "F" 101st Inf. Regiment, 26th Division. They were to attack from Nothum, (south of Wiltz and southeast of Bastogne) go down an open hill 400 yards, up another open hill to a cemetery and continue upgrade to a woods another 200 yards, all in the snow and sticking out like sore thumbs in their G.I. khaki. Next to the woods was hill 490 and the famous Cafe Schumann Crossroads. They were green and got shot to pieces yet managed in spite of near panic to take them. We took pictures from both ends - the American view and then the German view. You could almost relive it. Even the German foxholes are there 33 years later - even one laid out for a machine gun, at the edge of the wood - plus the site of a big self propelled gun. I'm told they were still bringing out bodies three months later, as the snows melted. About 3,000 total casualties on both sides in this push. Luxembourgers don't easily forget Americans.

Remember that cheap commodity called gasoline? Over in France its price is set by the government, the same all through the country. It was in our money \$2.40 a gallon (not a litre) and 80% of that goes back to the government. When you go to any of these places especially the cemeteries, get Michelin maps - the best ever - and one folder from any American Cemetery concerning all cemeteries in Europe.

In France it was still the same impression in both Wars - "Cherchez la Femme." It's still the same today. They know how to dress and retain their femininity. No jeans for them - only dresses and high heels. 'Tis nothing to see a woman in high heels pushing a baby carriage along a National Highway as trucks whiz by, nor to see one driving a Motor Bike in the same fashion. Except for high heels, Fifi D'Orsay and the Mademoiselle from Armentiered would feel right at home.

And so ends my odyssey or pilgrimage. Call it what you will. I call it: "A Love Affair."
